Adhering to its mission and vision, the PUP College of Engineering Honors' Society is committed to producing caliber students. In line with this, it is but appropriate to give honor to its catered community – the students who opt to serve and whom the society dedicates its effort. Moreover, honor is given to those who seek the college proud of, the worthy member of the society – Knight of the Intellectuals, the young with promising potential – Virtue of David, the exceptional leader – Wisdom of Hammurabi, the exemplary achiever – Legacy of Da Vinci, the outstanding academicians – Wisdom of Solomon, the finest scholar – Tanglaw ng Iskolalar, the persistent graduating student – Victory of Augustus Caesar, the laudable educator/teacher – Teachings of Newton, the incomparable officer of the organization who devotes wholeheartedly, and performs effectively and efficiently as an officer towards achieving organization's mission and vision – Pag-asa ni Rizal, and the thriving organization of the college – Golden Gear Award.

HISTORY

The search started on 2002 under the leadership of Mr. Kim S. Nitural, believing that due recognition is an important morale booster for the students, the awards had been conceptualized and realized on December of the same year consisting of the four: Exemplary Achiever, Exceptional Leader, Excellent Academician and Outstanding Scholar.

On its second year, being inspired by the effects and support of professors and mentors, another category was added and named "Laudable Educator/Teacher". Running smoothly, the third year followed, giving more emphasis on the true meaning of the five categories as Vision of Hammurabi, Legacy of Da Vinci, Wisdom of Solomon, Tanglaw ng Iskolalar and Teachings of Newton.

On its fourth year, the search continued aiming to recognize future experts and leaders, who will serve as role models for the students. On its fifth year, essay writing of candidates, which was a part of the final screening, was replaced with extemporaneous speaking to emphasize contestants' ability to decision making and delivering points of view through verbal communication. Moreover, the Knight of Intellectuals was added to award the untiring member of the society.

On its sixth year, the award giving body strengthened its wings through reflecting its frodity, revising and reformatting the entire pointing system. The search was divided into four stages, namely, Initial Screening, Second Screening, Final Screening and I-Speak Polls. Moreover, due to persistent efforts and perseverance of graduating students of the college, the society saw the necessity to replace the Knight of Intellectuals with the Victory of Augustus Caesar. The award recognized commendable hard works of graduating students of the academic year.

On the seventh year, the award giving body, resolves to continue the victory in bringing the best upon students, initiated the Virtue of David, which called as a great avenue for students possessing great potentials to become one of the most promising leaders. Furthermore, pointing system was improved to attain the goal of the award giving body as that particular year – to focus on the passion for change and boldness to rise for change of every participant.

On its eighth year, marked up and proved that true intellects must have the right character to achieve goal, must bring the best upon others and must be dynamic towards grasping the moment, standing up for principles and transformation for progress. Thus, the search was divided into three stages, namely, Initial Screening, Final Screening and I-Speak Polls. Continuing the quest for students with exceptional potential as young leaders, the ninth year marked another tremendous year as it set high standards. The search was divided into four stages: Initial Screening, Second Screening, Final Screening, and I-Speak Polls. It was also in this year that the first Solidarity Night started, a team building activity which helps participants to enrich themselves.

Celebrating a decade of success, the search soared high and continued producing competent and outstanding students on its tenth year. It was in this year that the very first Pag-asa ni Rizal awardee was proclaimed, an award given to exceptional officer to the organization who devotes himself/herself wholeheartedly, and performs effectively and efficiently as an officer towards achieving organization's mission and vision.

On the eleventh year, the organization decided to change the Tanglaw Project into the Tanglaw Seminar to produce new generation of student leaders that will be pillars of excellence. Changes were also made, from the criteria for judging, up to the scoring system for categories.

On its twelfth year, extemporaneous speaking for Wisdom of Solomon category, which was a part of the final screening, was replaced with a written examination emphasizing the candidates' knowledge in different fields of engineering sciences. The "Piso Vote" was also replaced by the E-drive where candidates collected plastic bottles and used papers for junk.

On its thirteenth year, Vision of Hammarabi was made open for nominations from all organizations in the College of Engineering. Also, Photo Contest was adopted as a replacement for Poster Making. The "Piso Vote" was returned as part of I-speak polls and as a replacement to E-drive.

On its fourteenth year, an additional award was added. This was termed the Golden Gear Award. This award aims to recognize commendable organization significantly contributing to the mission and vision of the College of Engineering. The first awardee of the category was the Electronics Engineering Students' Society (ECESS).

On its fifteenth year, the award giving body set an even higher standard by revising the pointing system. The search was divided into two stages: Initial Screening and Final Screening. Influencing the prime students towards the re-establishment of the college's own debate society, a Debate Contest was introduced as part of the Final Screening.

GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

1. Contestants should be official participants of the 17th Tanglawing Iskolar Awards – Virtus of David, Vision of Hamunabi, Wisdom of Salomon, Legacy of De Vind, Victory of Augustus Caesar and Tanglawing Iskolar categories.
2. The contest is divided into three (3) rounds of different difficulties – Easy, Average, and Difficult.
3. Participants must arrive at the venue 15 minutes before the official start. Once the contest has started, late comers cannot play anymore.
4. They will be grouped into (5) five groups consisting of (8) members from the eight different categories.
5. This is an elimination type of competition. At the end of the 1st round, 3 groups will be chosen. At the end of the 2nd round, only 2 groups will be left. And at the end of the 3rd round, only 1 group will be announced as the winner.
6. Groups which have been eliminated after the 1st round will get 50 points. The group that will be eliminated in the 2nd round will get 75 points. And the group that will be eliminated in the 3rd round will get 90 points.
7. Topics of the questions varies from collegiate issues and social issues.
8. Any violations on the rules of the contest is subjected to disqualification. Three (3) warnings are given before disqualification on the Case Study Competition.

DEBATE CONTEST GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

General rules

1. This contest is open to the official participants of the 17th Tanglaw ng Iskolalar Awards – Virtue of David, Legacy of Da Vinci, Vision of Hammurabi, Wisdom of Solomon, Victory of Augustus Caesar, Tanglaw ng Iskolalar and Golden Gear categories.
2. The debate format that will be used is the All Asia Debate or Asian Parliamentary Debate. Match-ups are to be announced before motions are revealed.
3. The sides to be defended by either shall be determined by a coin toss.
4. Any clarification regarding the rules shall be addressed to and entertained by the committee of the Debate before the start of the event proper.

Adjudication

1. The adjudication of the debate will be based on Matter (40%), Manner (40%) and Method (20%).
2. There will be no draws.
3. Decisions of the Panel of Adjudicators are final and irrevocable.

Motions

1. The motions to be included cover local, national, and international issues. All motions are direct or closed.
2. Each adjudicator with the help of the committee will make up issues that are to be debated upon and an issue will be drawn by the chair thirty (30) minutes before each match start. Debaters will utilize this time to prepare for their respective cases.

Debate Proper

1. During the match, the speakers both from the Government and the Opposition sides will be granted seven (7) minutes to deliver their constructive speeches.
2. After the first (1st) minute of the speech, Points of Information (PoI's) are allowed. A member holding the floor must respond to opposing member, or members offering PoI's through a clear gesture or hand signal rejecting the offer, verbal rejection of the offer, or verbal acceptance of the offer. On the last minute of a constructive speech, points of information will not be entertained to allow each speaker to summarize their cases.
3. The reply speaker on the other hand, will be given four (4) minutes to summarize the team's case. It is imperative that the reply speaker will not provide additional or new facts on the cases of their respective teams or else will be subjected to penalties.
4. Teams must prepare on their own. They must arrive on the venue 15 minutes before the scheduled time.
5. The alternate is allowed to prepare with the debaters but is not allowed to sit with them during the debate proper. The alternate can nonetheless stay inside the venue during the debate.

Timing of the Speeches

1. The timing of each speech starts at the moment the speaker begins talking.
2. It is the duty of the timekeeper, a panel member or the chair of the panel to keep track of the time.
3. Speeches will be seven (7) minutes in duration. After the first minute of the speech delivery, a tap will signal that POCs are entertained. The second tap, at the start of 6th minute will signal that POCs are already not allowed. The timekeeper with two (2) strikes will signal the end of the seventh minute. Speaker should take at least one (1), preferably two (2) points of information in his/her speech.
4. In case of overtime, an additional thirty seconds is allowed for each speaker to finish or clear his case.
5. It is the discretion of the panel of adjudicators to deduct points from the speaker who renders speech over the limit.

Other Provisions

1. During the delivery of every speech, applause, clapping of hands or shouting are not permitted. If the audience favors the arguments of each team, they should tap their armchairs or say "hear/hear". On the contrary, simply say, "shame/shame".
2. Unruly behavior such as embarrassing, insulting, harassing or any similar gestures is not allowed. If this would happen, the members of the committee and the chairman of the contest may decide to disqualify any team from further joining the contest.
