RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES

1. Responsibility of TESDA-Manila:
 - A. Provide training regulations as basis for the development of the training manuals/regulations/modules of the second party;
 - B. Waived the Assessment fee for the partner barangay beneficiaries (who is currently working and can provide certificate of employment) of the second party applying for certification through the Competency Assessment and Certification for Workers (CACW) Program.
2. Respondents of PUP:
 - A. Develop and provide free training manuals/regulations/modules training beneficiaries based on the training regulations or TESDA develop by the expert and/or qualified personnel and faculty members from various colleges, branches and offices;
 - B. Provide free trainings in terms of night classes parallel to the training regulations provided by TESDA;
 - C. Monitor and evaluate the performance of students/trainees in the classes during the duration of the training;
 - D. Provide assistance to the members of the partner barangay beneficiaries in the process of applying for certification;
 - E. Provide assistance the members of partner barangay beneficiaries in the preparation of the necessary documents (includes the application form, self-assessment form, etc.) in the process of applying for certification; and
 - F. Submit documentary requirements and/or terminal report of the conduct of the training courses provided to the first party.
3. To implement this MOA, specific undertakings/project/programs shall be appropriately covered by a separate Terms of Reference (TOR) and Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) that will define and detail the responsibilities and commitments of parties involved in such undertakings duly signed by the authorized signatories of each party.
